Recycling Basics

METAL
ONLY Aluminum and Tin Cans and Tops

NO Hangars, pots pans, utensils, etc.

GLASS
ONLY Glass Bottles and Jars – NO LIDS

NO windows, dishes, drinking, eyeglasses, or broken glass, etc.

 **PLASTIC** 
ONLY #'s 1 & 2

NO plastic bags, toys, buckets, coolers, kitchen utensils, etc.

PAPER-CARDBOARD
ONLY Newspapers, Magazines, Junk Mail, Corrugated Cardboard and Boxes

NO milk cartons, egg cartons, food or pizza boxes, etc.

Hazardous Waste

Automotive Products (antifreeze, fluids, motor oil, oil filters, gasoline, polish and wax)
 Vehicle Batteries (auto, marine, ATV, ride on mower)
 Tires
 Fluorescent Light Bulbs and CFL's
 Household Cleaners (ammonia, drain cleaner, rust remover, tile/shower cleaner and more)
 Mercury Containing Items: thermometers, thermostats
 Paint Products (oil-based paint, spray paint, caulk, wood preservative, wood stain)
 Garden Chemicals (pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, insecticides)
 Swimming Pool Chemicals
 Sharps (needles and lancets) and Pharmaceuticals

- Rechargeable Batteries
- CD's, DVD's, and Cases Old Gift Cards
